Cost:

- 300 euro + membership (details below).
- WWG cat. A 40 euro
- Trip Leader \$70
- If you purchase more than one certificate, the second will cost \$15. For example: Trip Leader \$70 + Safety Kayaker \$15 = \$85.

How do I reserve?

- Pay 50%.
- The remaining 50% must be paid before the start of classes.
- If you decide not to participate, you will receive a full refund up to 20 days before the start of the course/workshop.
- If you notify us that you will not participate between 19 and 15 days before the start of the course/workshop, you will receive a 50% refund of the amount you used to make the reservation.
- There will be no refund at all (zero) 14 days before the start of the course/workshop.
- Payment can be made via bank transfer, e-wallet, or cash.

Prerequisites:

Each candidate must provide their own personal protective equipment (PPE).

Watersports helmet, personal flotation device, clothing suitable for spending several hours in the water, footwear with closed toes (NO sandals with neoprene socks), knife, whistle, watch.

(PRE) Personal Rescue Equipment.

3 HMS-type carabiners with manual or automatic locking mechanism.

2 nylon (polyamide) cords 2 to 3 mm thinner than the diameter of your own throw line. (115 cm length recommended)

1 tubular nylon (polyamide) webbing (4 meters recommended) - flip line.

1- Throw bag with carrying belt.

Packrafter: Skirt, paddle, Packrarf, and personal equipment.

The workshop includes:

- IRF certified instructor
- Classroom
- First aid kit

The course does NOT include:

- PPE / ERP / Packrarf or gear.
- Accommodation
- Meals

IRF Materials: There are many important informational documents to help candidates understand the federation and be better prepared. Ask your instructor for these documents! But first, you'll need to read them before asking questions 😊
