



Workshop IRF de 3 days – Czech Republic - PRAGUE.

DATE: 25, 26, 27 of May 2026

This is your moment. On one of Praga's most renowned courses.

Be evaluated under the official protocols of the International Rafting Federation (IRF)
Become part of and exchange experiences with a global network of river professionals
Contribute to a safer, more professional, and internationally recognized future for rafting
Elevate your technical and professional level
Official certification – Limited spaces – Nature, challenge, and international exposure.

Site Specific definition,

A person who has been awarded a Site Specific certification is restricted to operate only at the site specifically named on the award.

Site Specific locations are whitewater areas that rarely (if ever) change in volume or flow characteristics, such as a dam-controlled river or an artificially constructed whitewater venue. At such locations, it is possible for a Guide to perform competently by memorising the run rather than by developing river reading skills.

Site Specific certifications are not given a Level designation, but instead a specific site (as described above) is named on the certification. The site will include the venue name or river and section name. Site Specific awards are valid only at the named site, and only when the conditions are equal to those that are normally encountered at the named site.

Cost:

- 330 euro + membership (details below)
- River Guide: \$40 USD
- Safety Kayaker: \$40 USD
- Trip Leader: \$70 USD
- If you obtain more than one certificate, the second will cost \$15 USD. For example: Trip Leader: \$70 USD + Safety Kayaker: \$15 USD = \$85 USD.

How do I reserve?

- A 50% deposit is required.
- The remaining 50% must be paid before the start of classes.
- If the candidate decides not to participate, they will receive a full refund of the deposited amount up to 20 days before the start of the course/workshop.
- If notification of non-participation is received between 19 and 15 days before the start of the course/workshop, only 50% of the deposit will be refunded.
- No refunds will be issued 14 days before the start of the course/workshop.
- Payment can be made via bank transfer, digital wallet, or cash.

Prerequisites:

Each candidate must provide their own personal protective equipment (PPE).

(PPE) Personal Protective Equipment.

Watersports helmet, personal flotation device, clothing suitable for spending several hours in the water, footwear with closed toes (NO sandals with neoprene socks), knife, whistle, watch.

(PPE) Personal Rescue Equipment.

4 HMS-type carabiners with manual or automatic locking mechanisms.

3 pulleys, at least one of which must be for prusik knot capture.

2 nylon (polyamide) cords 2 to 3 mm thinner than the diameter of your own throw line. (115 cm length recommended)

1 nylon (polyamide) tubular webbing (4 meters recommended) - flip line.

1 throw bag with carrying belt.

The workshop includes:

- Evacuation workshop with some content from the IRF GTP
- IRF certified instructor
- Equipment, rafts
- PDF reading material
- Classroom
- Membership
- First aid kit

The course does NOT include:

- PPE / ERP
- Accommodation
- Meals

IRF Materials: There are many important informational documents to help candidates understand the federation and be better prepared. Ask your instructor for these documents!
